RIDGEWOOD JUNIOR FOOTBALL CODE OF CONDUCT

All parents, players and coaches shall:

1. Emphasize sportsmanship, ethical conduct and fair play at all times. All participants shall be courteous to all opponents and their coaches, the officials, and opposing fans. Everyone must conduct themselves in a positive and exemplary fashion, reflecting the ideals of Ridgewood Junior Football, thereby making the athletic contest a positive experience for our children.
2. Refrain from using physical or verbal abuse, profane language, criticism of either team, its players, coaches, or referees by word of mouth, gesture or by rooting for their own team in such a manner that "taunts" or "provokes" the opposing team or players during any game, scrimmage, or practice.
3. Accept decisions of the game officials (including referees and coaches) on the field as being fair and called to the best ability of said officials. Only the head coach may challenge calls, albeit in a professional manner, and if not satisfied, may issue a protest under the league rules.

Violation of the Code of Conduct

1. Ridgewood Junior Football shall have the authority to impose a penalty on anyone who violates the code of conduct.
2. Anyone who violates the code of conduct will first be asked to refrain from this behavior. Failure to heed this warning, and continued abuse, may lead to physical removal from the site of the game, practice, or scrimmage.
3. Failure to abstain from this behavior or to leave upon request may result in a suspension from further participation and risk the future participation of his/ her children in the program.
4. The executive committee and, if necessary, the Board of Directors, will decide the duration of any suspension of the individual in violation and further remedies, if justified.
